## CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

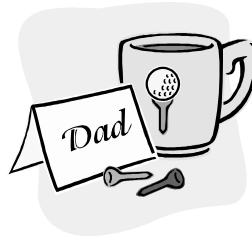
My dear sons,  
I refer to you as sons because I, of course, am spiritual father to this parish family and to each of you, Knights young and old. Also, I do so because I just heard many beautiful reflections during a silent retreat which focused in developing our devotion to God the Father.

Many of us pray more to Jesus and to Mary, but perhaps some childish resentment or rebelliousness causes us to talk to God the Father only rarely.

There is a story of a priest in Mexico who worked as chaplain in an overcrowded prison and was amazed that all of the men wanted



to go to confession to him. As he gave absolution he always put his left hand on the penitent's shoulder as he blessed him with the right hand. He was surprised that these tough, macho men would often sob as he did this. He could not understand this. Later, when Mothers' Day approached he noticed that all of these inmates wanted Mothers' Day cards to send. So when Father's Day came he bought a box of Father's Day cards for them, but not one of the cards was used! The priest then understood that, as a priest, he was the only good father figure these men had. They never had a loving, gentle father to teach them how to be men, and so interiorly they



were very fragile and insecure.

There is a great "father hunger" in our modern world. In the church, and in the ranks of the Knights, we must be the good fathers that people need. I thank the Knights for their historic support for priests who are the spiritual fathers that people need!

## Lecturer's Notes: January: A New Beginning

***“When you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, who love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on street corners so that others may see them. Amen, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you pray, go to your inner room, close the door, and pray to your Father in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will repay you. In praying, do not babble like the pagans, who think that they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them. Your Father knows what you need before you ask him.***

***“This is how you are to pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread; and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors; and do not subject us to the final test, but deliver us from the evil one, if you forgive others their transgressions, your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your transgressions.”***  
**Matt 6:5-15**



“The Lord’s Prayer is the perfect prayer of the Christian. It puts God, our Father, first. It asks only for what we need and calls us to forgive others, so that we may have hope for forgiveness by God.” (RCIA Catechist’s Manual Proclamation ACM © 2005). The Lord’s Prayer is also known as “The Perfect Prayer,” why? Because this is the only time that Jesus said, **“This is how you are to pray.”** He then gave us a prayer as well as an outline for how to pray.

Jesus, the second person of the Godhead, gives us instruction on how to address Him and what to ask for. And this is a huge clue as to how we should orient our private prayer, our worship, and our lives. St. Thomas Aquinas said: “The Lord’s Prayer is the most perfect of prayers.... In it we ask, not only for all the things we can rightly desire, but also in the sequence that they should be desired. This prayer not only teaches us to ask for things, but also in what order we should desire them.” (S Th II-II, 83,9. CCC 2763)

So let’s discuss The Lord’s prayer and its importance in our private prayer, our worship, and our lives. Jesus starts by revealing something about God’s love for us, His fallen children. When he says; “Our Father” he defines for us the

relationship God intended from before creation; the relationship of a father and his child. God wants a loving, nurturing, growing relationship of love and trust with each of us.

This is not a master/slave relationship of power and obedience with any use of force or punishment. This was meant to be a life giving exchange of love between family members as a parent with a child.

Join me next month as we look at the first three petitions of the Lord’s Prayer.
