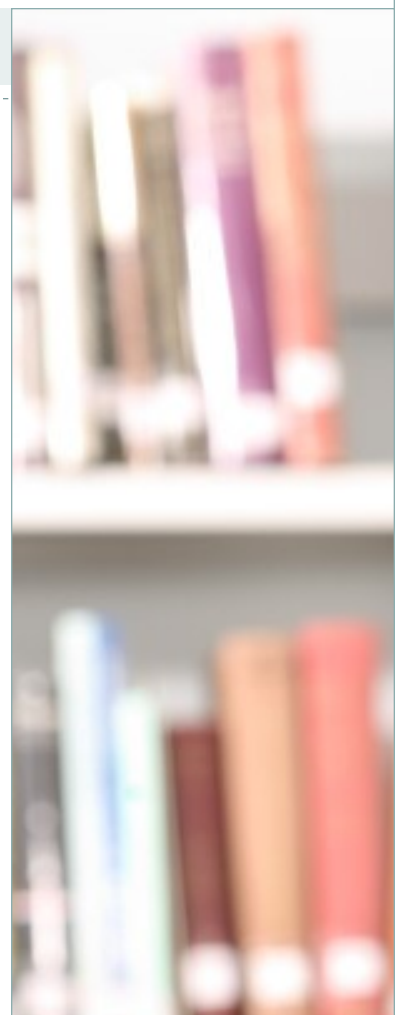

# FATHER MARK'S MESSAGE

Soon and very soon, we will celebrate once again the amazing fact of the virginal birth of the God-Man. Even the angels were amazed and a heavenly host appeared to the shepherds singing "Glory to God in the highest."
