

# CHAPLAIN'S MARCH MESSAGE

Brothers,



I pray that many of you took up my challenge last month and are well on your way to being consecrated to our council's patron, St. Joseph. It would be a shame that more men of St. Joseph are not consecrated to him. It really isn't too late. The group consecration of families, our parish, and of our diocese will take place on St. Joseph's feast day, the 19th of this month as part of the 5:45 PM mass. Even if you aren't ready on the 19th, it is still a very worthwhile process.



I have heard a couple of our brothers saying how sad they are that we are only able to do two fish fry dinners this year, and both in a drive-by format. It still won't be the way fish fry dinner used to be before the pandemic. There won't be the 400-600 people coming to spend time together in the hall. The council won't be able to make the same amount of money. We will still be able to play our role in bringing people together. If they are joyful (yes, even during Lent we are called to be joyful) the peo-

ple who purchase their Friday dinners from us, will see the sacrifice of our brothers who are able to help out and see us as examples of how men are called by God to behave. He calls all of us to sacrifice and give to our community with joyful hearts and faces, even when we have to wear a mask to cover our smiles. We are called to give, even when it hurts or when we think we don't have the time. Our efforts and sacrifices can help to evangelize those who see us.



In the same manner, if we act in a "negative" manner - - complaining about the lack of turnout, the lack of other brothers who aren't able to help out, about not having enough money as a council, or even about restrictions from the parish to what the council can or cannot do -- we send a message that we are a group of grumpy, old men instead of a group of God loving men.

It is all about our attitude. There are things, like the pandemic, that are totally beyond our control. If we spend our time concentrating on those things and allowing them to create a feel-



**Brothers;**


**Now that we are in Lent Season, and as we fast in preparation to receive the Holy Spirit, we must keep our hearts, mind and spirit clean.**
