





SEPTEMBER LECTURER REFLECTION

My Brothers;

September is here, during September we are called to contemplate and more closely align ourselves with the sufferings of our Blessed Mother. September 15 is the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows and the entire month is dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrows. How can we align ourselves with our Blessed Mothers sufferings? First we must know what they are.

First Sorrow: Simeon's Prophecy,

"And Simeon blessed them and said to Mary His Mother, behold this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel and will be a sign that will be contradicted and you yourself a sword will pierce so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed. (Luke 2:34-35)

Second Sorrow: The Flight into Egypt,

"When they had departed, behold, the Angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, "Rise, take the child and his mother, flee to Egypt and stay there until I tell you. Herod is going to search for the child to destroy him." Joseph rose and took the child and his mother and departed to Egypt. (Matthew 2:13-16)

Third Sorrow: The Loss of the Child Jesus in The Temple,

"When his parents saw him, they were astonished, and his mother said to him, "Son, why have you done this to us? Your father and I have been looking for you with great anxiety." And he said to them, "Why were you looking for me? Did you not understand that I must be in my fathers house?" But they did not understand what he said to them. He went down and with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them; and his mother kept all these things in her heart. (Luke 2:48-52)

Fourth Sorrow: Meeting Jesus on the Way of the Cross,

We can only imagine the tremendous suffering that Mary must have endured as she encountered her Son, Her Lord, once more, but so so quickly this moment must have passed. She knew that her Son had embraced his suffering, as he was, after all, carrying His Cross, she knew she must embrace it with him.

Fifth Sorrow: Mary Witnesses the Crucifixion and the Death of Jesus on the Cross;

For three hours she stood. Even with John by her side to help comfort her, her anguish as she watched her only Son tortured so completely, must have been immeasurable, and yet she did not fall or turn away until the end. Her courage and strength were tremendous.

SEPTEMBER LECTURER REFLECTION CONT.

Sixth Sorrow: The Body of Jesus is Take Down and Laid in the Arms of His Holy Mother; It is Finished. Could this be the end... it could not. How can we know how she feels? Without knowing God's full plan, this must be her greatest moment of sorrow. How can any mother hold the lifeless body of their child?

She knows that God has a plan. Hopefully she had some sense of what redemptive power his suffering and death had.

Seventh Sorrow: The Burial of Jesus, with Mary's Tears and Loneliness;

Now in the place where he had been crucified there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb, in which no one had yet been buried. So they laid Jesus there because of the Jewish preparation day; for the tomb was close by. (John 19:41)

This devotion passed on by Saint Bridget can be practiced quite simply. We must contemplate of each of her seven sorrows while praying a Hail Mary for each sorrow. For this devotion the Blessed Virgin grants her devotees seven graces.

Here are the seven graces:

- 1) I will grant peace to their families.**
- 2) They will be enlightened about the divine mysteries.**
- 3) I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work.**
- 4) I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of my divine Son or sanctification of their souls.**
- 5) I will defend them in their spiritual battles with the internal enemy and I will protect them at every instant of their lives.**
- 6) I will visibly help them at the moment of their death they will see the face of their Mother.**
- 7) I have obtained from my divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to my tears and dolors, will be taken directly from this earthly life to eternal happiness since all their sins will be forgiven and my Son and I will be there eternal consolation and joy.**

These are seven Graces that would bless the life of each and every one of us. Let's join together this month and practice this powerful devotion.
